

BT Open Reach Public Statement

As a result of Dialogue between Buckshaw Residents Association (Rebecca Stapleton Harris) and Openreach (Colin Brooks) and subsequent review of our Superfast Broadband deployment in Leyland Exchange and its impact on Buckshaw Village

The following has been agreed by Openreach Monday 5th September 2011

Cabs 58& 59

Cab 58 (Situated on Junction of Central Ave & Old Worden Avenue) & Cab 59 (near Rimmers Pharmacy located on Central Avenue) will both be deployed under the Openreach National Rollout Programme (without additional funding for Openreach being required from the community), expected Deployment date is the second half of 2012 – More specific dates for the cabs will be provided sooner to the time of deployment

5 Additional cabs (not including 58 & 59)

We will continue to review the other 5 cabinets situated on Buckshaw Village in line with our standard commercial roll out plans, also as you may be aware there is currently a competitive Tender process in place for a Countywide Superfast Broadband deployment in Lancashire (which BT is currently Tendering for) with the successful Bidder being expected to be announced by December 2011

Openreach will continue to update the Buckshaw Residents Association on any impact that could affect the other 5 cabinets in Buckshaw Village once it becomes clearer
