Previous Meetings – Monday 9th NOVEMBER 2011

Dear Residents,

A big thank you to all members who took the time to attend our recent P.a.c.t. meeting as referred to above.

Officers present offered the usual briefing with reference to recent crime figures and actions taken towards last month's priority. Following this the following items were discussed:-

- Bonfire Night / The Hub** - Those present celebrated the fact that Guy Fawkes night and the opening of the Hub the following day took place without incident.
- Trinity School** - Erection of speed restriction signs outside the school ... this issue has been raised with Redrow builders. Further discussions are to take place.
- Village Way / Main St & Old Worden Ave** - It is the considered opinion of those present that the roundabout situated at this junction is too dark. However, it is hoped that this situation will soon be remedied by the builders.
- Ordnance Rd** - ... leading to Tesco suffers from the problem mentioned above, as many of the street lights are not working. This area is regularly used by pedestrians and currently the roads and pavements are very uneven, with sunken manhole covers etc. *It is, therefore, hoped that the street lighting here can be improved in the near future.*
- Buckshaw Village** - (a) It is very apparent that a number of cars are now parking vehicles with all four wheels on pavements, leaving very little room for wheelchairs, mobility scooters and/or pushchairs. Members requested that something be done to these thoughtless individuals.
- (b) There continues to be instances of dog fouling. It evident that the hours of darkness arrive earlier and continue later and this has augmented the problem. Too many inconsiderate dog owners are NOT cleaning up after their dogs.

WE WOULD LIKE TO REMIND THESE PEOPLE THAT SUCH AN OFFENCE CARRIES A £70 FINE!
