

Residents Meeting – September 2011 Feedback

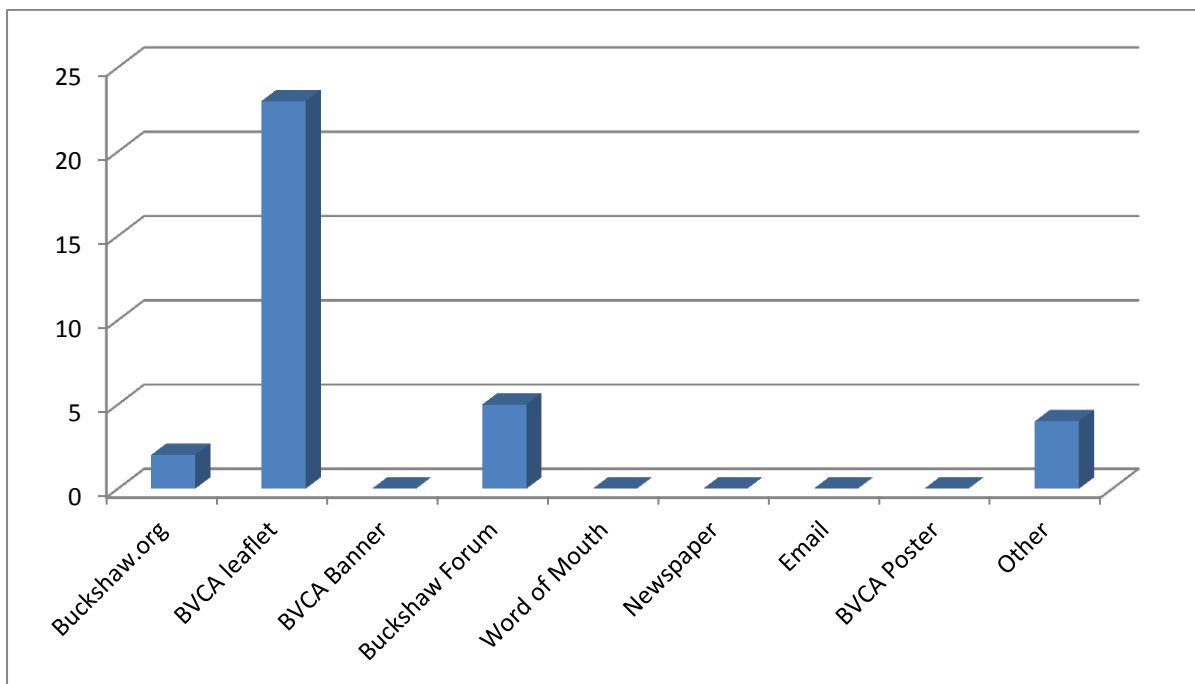

Where did you find out about today's event?

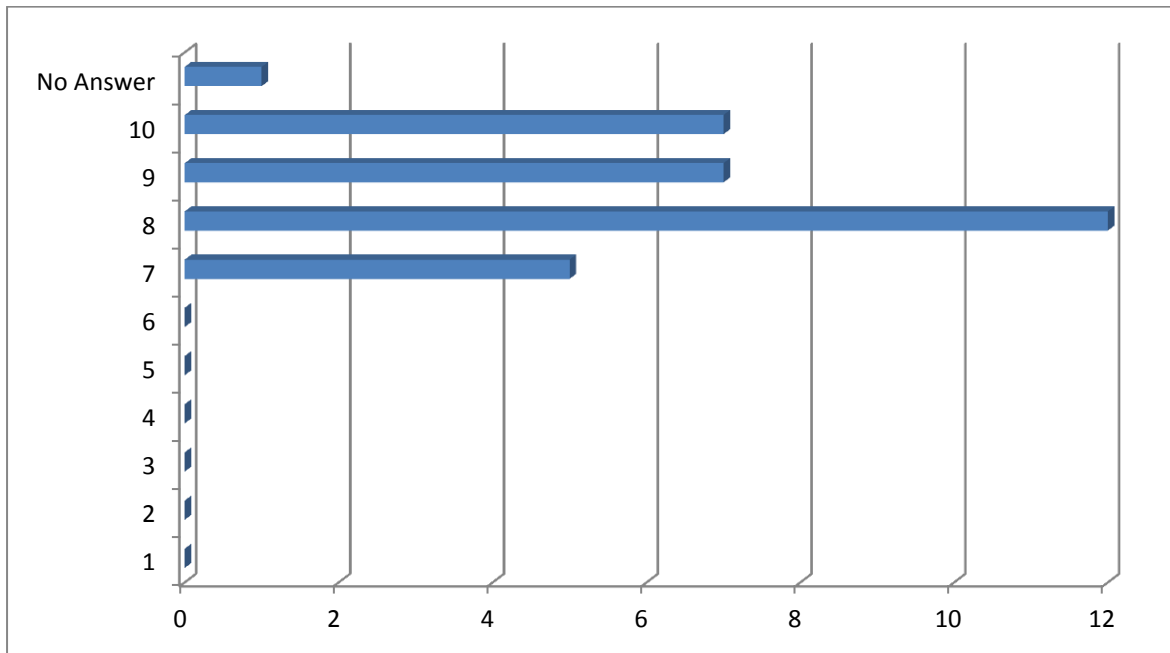

Question 2

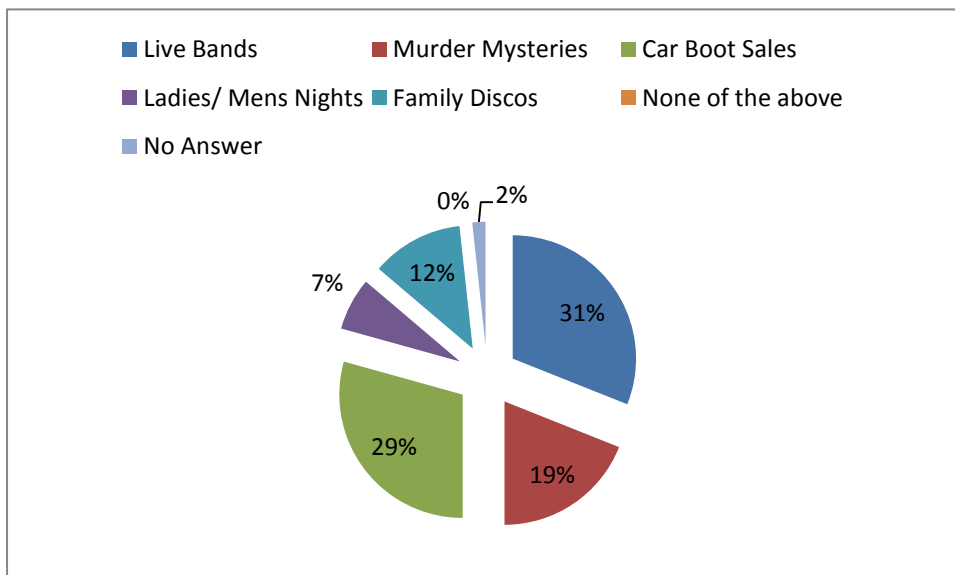
On a scale of 1 to 10, 10 being the highest, how would you score today's event?

What other events would you like to see the BVCA host?

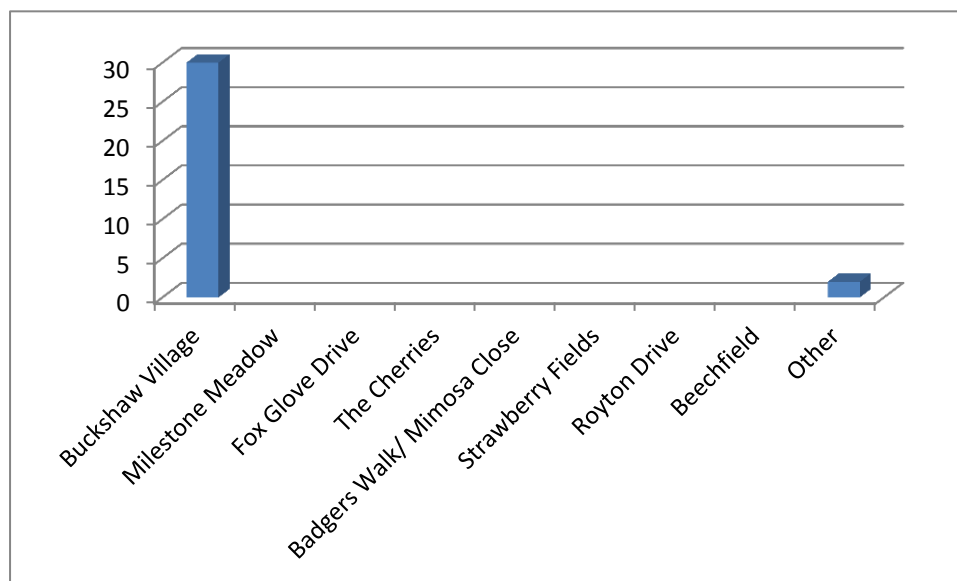
